The panel will be looking for your thoughtful submission and understanding of how your project/program promotes public awareness, education and participation in environmental protection.

 - b. Economic
 - iv. Provide a description of how your project/program cost of implementing LID may decrease as experience increases and the benefits of using LID are realized in practice.
 1. If you can not provide such a description please provide details as to what the impediments are to decreasing long-term cost benefits of LID implementation.
 - v. Describe how your project/program included economic incentives, if applicable.
 - c. Outreach
 - vi. Provide a description of how your project/program promotes LID and communicates that these practices are safe, effective, and easy to implement.
